Thank you for your participation in the Philadelphia Friends of V 12th Annual Jimmy V "Four Special Days" basketball event (February 19th through February 22, 2015). Like many organizations, we have been challenged to raise funds in a bumpy economy. One thing is certain; the fight against cancer continues and still needs our efforts.

In order to continue support at or exceeding prior year levels, we're asking for help from everyone to take action in the war against cancer and at the same time **make it personal** by recognizing an individual or family you know that has been affected by cancer. What:

- Contributions can be solicited from friends, families and neighbors (ex. *Grandma, Uncle, Cousin, Neighbor.... Hi, I'm playing in a Jimmy V basketball game to raise funds for cancer research in February.... would you make a donation and help me fight this disease?*) If applicable: I'm playing in honor of (deceased name) or in support of (survivor name)
- Parents and or other supporters who attend the games are also encouraged to take part in this fund raising campaign.

Incentives

For every \$50.00 raised (1) one entry on your behalf will be placed in a 'bucket' and the winner will be drawn during the 4 day event: A choice of an IPAD or 2 courtside seats at Madison Square Garden for the Jimmy V College Classic in December 2015. (Winner will be contacted if not present at the time of the drawing).

- For every \$50.00 raised an 'I Don't Give Up For (named cancer victim or survivor)'
 certificate will be displayed the wall during the 4 day event on your behalf.
- Recognition of extraordinary fund raising efforts will also be announced throughout the four days.
